It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 7 V.S.A. § 1002(g) is amended to read:

(g) No person shall engage in the retail sale of tobacco products, <u>tobacco</u> <u>substitutes, substances containing nicotine or otherwise intended for use with a</u> <u>tobacco substitute, or tobacco paraphernalia</u> in the State unless the person is a licensed wholesale dealer as defined in 32 V.S.A. § 7702 or has purchased the tobacco products, <u>tobacco substitutes</u>, <u>substances containing nicotine or</u> <u>otherwise intended for use with a tobacco substitute, or tobacco paraphernalia</u> from a licensed wholesale dealer.

Sec. 2. 7 V.S.A. § 1010(b) is amended to read:

(b) No person shall cause cigarettes, roll-your-own tobacco, little cigars, or snuff, <u>tobacco substitutes</u>, <u>substances containing nicotine or otherwise intended</u> <u>for use with a tobacco substitute</u>, <u>or tobacco paraphernalia</u>, ordered or purchased by mail or through a computer network, telephonic network, or other electronic network, to be shipped to anyone other than a licensed wholesale dealer or retail dealer in this State.

Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
